Second Consecutive Sellout Crowd Watches Revolution Stun Maryland at Ashe Center

Clover Hill HS wins first round of the SportsQuest Metro Bowl: Qualifies for Finals

SportsQuest enjoyed its second consecutive sellout crowd in a row for this week's **Bash at the Ashe**. A crowd of 3,513 fans bought tickets to watch the Richmond Revolution continue its winning ways. With one third of the season behind them, the undefeated Revolution enjoy a half game lead in the Atlantic East Division of the IFL. Thousands of fans turned out early and dozens brought their own tents to the pre-game **Bash at the Ashe** Tailgate party.

They edged out Manchester HS, who placed second and Cosby HS, who placed third in this week's qualifying round. A portion of the proceeds for the Metro Bowl ticket sales are donated each week to the athletic department of the schools that play.
